ADDITIONAL BENEFITS

- **1.** The IRA is a 10-year plan with credit policy in effect thru 2032. There are no caps on number of EVs sold by manufacturer as existed with the previous tax credit program.
- 2. There's also a 30% tax credit of up to \$1,000 for buying and installing a home EV charger in rural areas and some parts of Olympia, Lacey and Tumwater.
- 3. WA State sales tax is waived on first \$20,000 on purchase of an EV with MSRP under \$45,000
