

## A few suggestions for good stewardship

### **REDUCE AND RE-USE before recycling.**

Learn about and then use our alternative transportation systems. Walk or bike around campus...or use Panorama's Resident Transit. Leave the car at home.

Request a work order (#4205) to replace incandescent light bulbs with LED lights.

If you feel you must have outside lights all night, put them on a timer or motion sensor. Make sure they are off during daylight.

Consider reducing the amount of meat and dairy in your diet.

Put your computer and entertainment center on surge protectors and turn everything off when not in use.

Use water wisely.

## The Recycling Centers

The main (Jim Silver) Recycling Center is located in the parking lot to the west of the Auditorium and is open 7 days a week dawn to dusk. The Chinook Recycling Center is in the Chinook carport on Chambers Lake Lane.

There's a large green bin for:

- \* Paper: letters, magazines, newsprint
- \* Cardboard: Clean, and flattened
- \* Clean aluminum and tin cans  
Lids may be left on if attached to the can.  
Do not put lids in separately.
- \* Plastic bottles without lids
- \* Plastic diary tubs

**NO PLASTIC BAGS OR SHREDDED PAPER  
IN ANY BIN.**

### Separate Bins For:

- \* Glass bottles, rigid Styrofoam, batteries

### Food waste composting:

- \* All food and plant waste

**NO paper plates or drink cups**

**NO coffee pods**

**NO clam shells or deli containers**

**NO wax-coated milk/juice containers**
